THEATRE SHOW:

Our Students of classes VIII, IX, and X visited a Theatre show —**The Rise of Hitler** at LTG Auditorium, Centre Delhi on 17th August 2023. This workshop offered new insights and understandings to children of **Adolf Hitler**, the leader of Germany's Nazi Party, one of the most powerful and notorious dictators of the 20th century. After serving with the German military in World War I, Hitler capitalized on economic woes, popular discontent, and political infighting during the Weimar Republic to rise through the ranks of the Nazi Party.

In a series of ruthless and violent actions—including the Reichstag Fire and the Nightof Long Knives—Hitler took absolute power in Germany by 1933. Germany's invasion of Poland in 1939 led to the outbreak of World War II, and by 1941, Nazi forces had used "blitzkrieg" military tactics to occupy much of Europe. Hitler's virulent anti-

Semitism and obsessive pursuit of Aryan supremacy fueled the murder of some 6million Jews, along with other victims of the Holocaust. After the tide of war turnedagainst him, Hitler committed suicide in a Berlin





bunker in April 1945. This entire story was wonderfully enacted by the actors on a theatre stage. All thestudents experienced a new way of learning history interestingly.
