Dear Parents

We wish to inform you that Delhi government has issued certain guidelines through a circular number F.NO.DE.15(1025)/PSB/2023/7435-7439 dated 22/08/23 concerning the promotion of students in fifth and eighth grades for the academic session 2023-24.

The key points of the circular are as follows: -

- 1. In the event that a student does not pass an examination, he/she will be given the opportunity for a re-examination within two months from the date of result declaration.
- 2. If a student remains ineligible to pass even after the re-examination, they will be categorized as an "Essential Repeater."
- 3. Consequently, the student will be retained in the same class during the upcoming session.
- 4. For promotion to the next higher class, a student must attain an overall score of at least 33% in each subject, along with a minimum of 25% marks in the annual examination for every subject.
- 5. Maintaining a minimum of 75% attendance is also mandatory.
- 6. Regular assessment of the students of Grades III to VIII will be done regularly throughout the academic session as per the weightage of marks as given below table:
