



### **FOR CLASSES FIFTH AND EIGHTH**

Dear Parents

We wish to inform you that Delhi government has issued certain guidelines through a circular number F.NO.DE.15(1025)/PSB/2023/7435-7439 dated 22/08/23 concerning the promotion of students in fifth and eighth grades for the academic session 2023-24.

The key points of the circular are as follows: -

1. In the event that a student does not pass an examination, he/she will be given the opportunity for a re-examination within two months from the date of result declaration.
2. If a student remains ineligible to pass even after the re-examination, they will be categorized as an “Essential Repeater.”
3. Consequently, the student will be retained in the same class during the upcoming session.
4. For promotion to the next higher class, a student must attain an overall score of at least 33% in each subject, along with a minimum of 25% marks in the annual examination for every subject.
5. Maintaining a minimum of 75% attendance is also mandatory.
6. Regular assessment of the students of Grades III to VIII will be done regularly throughout the academic session as per the weightage of marks as given below table:
