Activity -1

• My Family Wheel (Activity)

- Take an A4 size sheet or cardboard and draw a big circle.
- Divide the circle into 4–5 equal parts (like a pizza 🍕).

In each part:

- Draw or paste a picture of one family member.
- Write their name (Mummy, Papa, Dadi, etc.)

Note- Colour and decorate your wheel.

Activity -2

Safety Traffic Light (Activity)

- Draw a traffic light with 3 circles:
 - ● Red (Stop): Write or draw 1 unsafe action (e.g., playing with fire)
 - ○ Yellow (Wait): Write careful behaviour. (e.g., look both sides before crossing the road)
 - ● Green (Go): Write a safe action (e.g., playing in a safe place)

Note- Colour properly (red, yellow, green).

Paste these circles neatly on a plain A4 sheet.

COMPUTER

- Draw parts of a computer (Monitor, CPU, Keyboard, Mouse) and colour them.
- Write any 3 uses of a computer .
- Write 5 lines on Computer .
- Draw a Happy Computer (Make a cartoon computer with eyes and smile).

- Find and cut pictures of 5 intelligent machines from old magazine, or newspaper with the help of your parents (like a washing machine, smart TV, tablets, vacuum cleaner) and paste them in computer notebook .
- NOTE- All work should be done in your computer notebook.
