  Shape Hunt in Nature – A Journey of Discovery!  

This holiday, turn into a Shape Explorer! Step outdoors and observe the wonders of nature through the lens of geometry. Your task is to go on a fun-filled "Shape Hunt" in natural surroundings—your garden, park, nearby trees, beach, or even your balcony!

Activity 1:   What to Do:

1. Explore your surroundings and spot natural objects that resemble basic shapes:

-  Circle (like a sunflower or a round stone)
-  Triangle (like a pine tree or a leaf tip)
-  Square or Rectangle (like a tile or a piece of bark)
-  Semi-circles, ovals, spirals—anything goes!

2. For each shape you find:

- Draw or paste a photo of the natural object on an A-4 sheet.
- Label the shape clearly.
- Mention where you found them and what object they were.

Activity 2 :-Nature Pattern Hunt – Maths Fun! 🌲

Create Your Own Nature Pattern 🍁 🪨 🌿

What to do:

1. Go outside to your garden/park and collect 3 different items:
